

Hidden dangerous goods

Some commonly used items may contain dangerous goods. An indication can be a coloured 'diamond' displayed on the item.

Artist Supplies	oil based paints, paint thinners etc.
Athletic Equipment	CO2 cartridges, ammunition, lifejackets, avalanche rescue backpack, batteries (cameras, go-pro)
Automotive/Car Parts	batteries, airbag modules, petrol etc.
Baggage	may contain lithium batteries e.g. a powerbank to recharge devices
Battery Powered Equipment, children toys	non-spillable batteries, unprotected batteries e.g. terminals, lithium batteries exceeding 160Wh or containing more than 2g of lithium metal
Camping/Expeditionary Equipment	flammable liquid (fuel), flammable gas cartridges/cylinders, fire starters, flares, emergency locator beacons, matches, hexamine etc.
Diving Equipment	high intensity diving lamps, compressed oxygen cylinders, shark repellents, batteries in self-propelling equipment etc.
Electrical Equipment	magnetised material, mercury in switches
Household Items	flammable cleaning products, corrosive oven/drain cleaner, fly spray, aerosols, pool chlorine, cooktop lighters, lighter refills, book matches, safety matches, CO2 cartridges e.g. soda stream cartridges, paint weed killer, fertilizer, pesticides etc.
Medical Supplies	flammable liquids (formaldehyde, ethanol) containing specimens/samples, thermometer, dry ice, etc.
Mercury Instruments	barometers, thermometers, monometers, switches
Party Supplies	sparklers, party poppers, fireworks
Petrol Powered Equipment	chainsaws, leaf blowers, whipper snippers, power generators, small outboard engines
Perishable Produce	dry ice
Photographic Supplies	ammonium hydroxide, batteries, cadmium bromide, potassium ferricyanide
Repair Kits	adhesives, organic peroxides, solvents, flammable liquids, oil-based paint, resin catalyst etc.
Toolboxes	explosives e.g. power nails or rivets, batteries, compressed gases or aerosols, butane gas cartridges, adhesives, corrosives, paint etc.
