

SINGAPORE CARRYING FIREARMS AND/OR AMMUNITION

The Singapore Air Navigation Orders requires all passengers traveling with firearms and/or ammunition flying to, through or from Singapore to apply for a permit with the Singapore Airport Authorities.

An 'Application of Permit for Carriage of Dangerous Goods/Munitions of War (For Sporting Purposes) Under the Air Navigation Order' form (see below) must be completed and submitted with the following documentation:

- full details of the firearms and ammunition;
- end user certificate (i.e. firearms licence);
- copy of the import/export certificate form;
- copy of the application form; and
- a commercial invoice for firearms being carried (this applies only to newly purchased firearms).

Note: *Failure to adhere to the requirement above will result in the application not being processed.*

SECURITY ESCORT FEE

This fee can include multiple passengers, travelling in the one group under the same booking reference, provided the inbound and outbound flights are the same.

Payment can be made:

- a) Prior to Departure

The Qantas Service Desks in Brisbane, Darwin, Melbourne, Perth or Sydney will be able to assist.

- b) Upon arrival in Singapore

Make yourself known to a Qantas staff member when you leave the aircraft. They will be able to assist you.

Note: *Security Escort Fee is not applicable if baggage remains on same aircraft in transit.*
