#### CARRYING FIREARMS AND/OR AMMUNITION THROUGH SINGAPORE

The Singapore Air Navigation Orders requires all passengers traveling with firearms or ammunition to, from or through Singapore, to apply for a permit with the Singapore Airport Authorities.

#### Carrying Firearms and Ammunition

An application form must be completed and submitted with the following documentation:

- Full details of the firearms and ammunition;
- End user certificate (i.e. firearms license);
- Copy of the import/export certificate form;
- Copy of the 'APPLICATION OF PERMIT FOR CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS/MUNITIONS OF WAR (FOR SPORTING PURPOSES) UNDER THE AIR NAVIGATION ORDER' form (attached below); and
- Commercial invoice of firearms to be carried (this applies only to newly purchased firearms).

**NOTE:** Failure to do so will result in the application not being processed.

## **Security Escort Fee**

SGD 136.00 (per journey, does not include the return flight).

This fee includes multiple passengers, traveling in the one group under the same booking reference, provided the inbound and outbound flights are the same.
